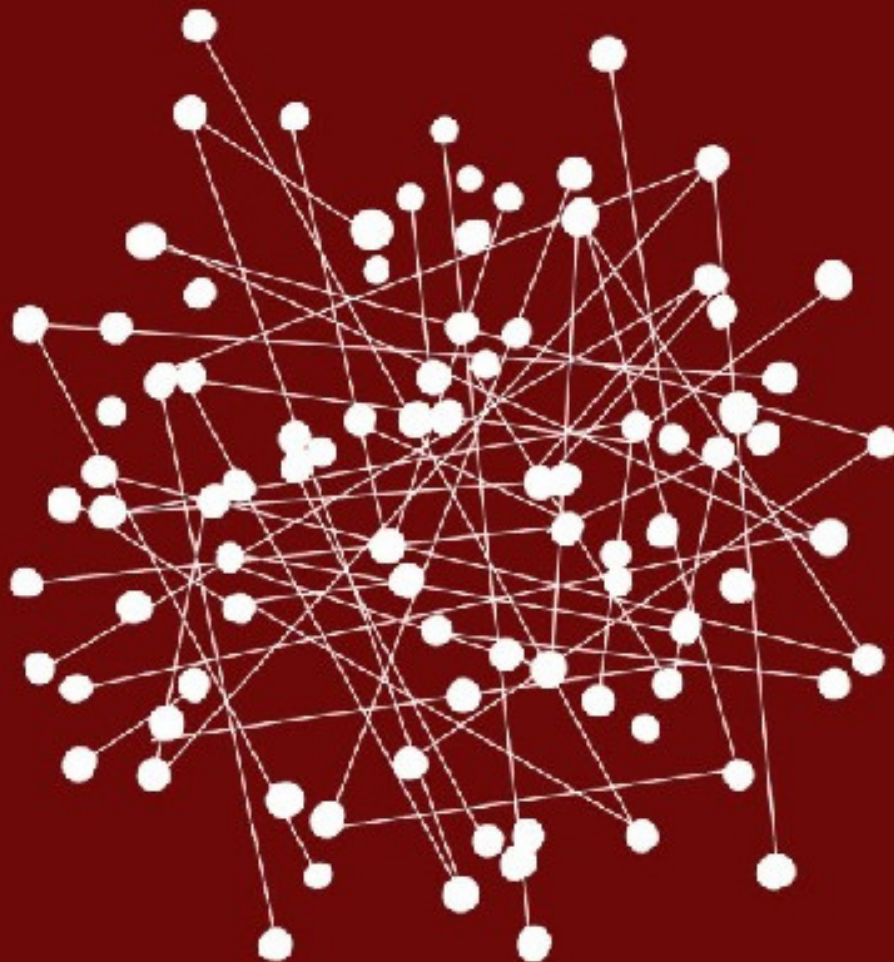

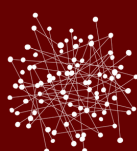

1. General

- These rules are subject to change and will be adjusted according to the current infection rates. In general, we always follow the official rules and regulations by the Dutch government. Their decisions overrule our guidelines at any time. For more information on the Dutch regulations read [here](#).
- CIROS is committed to organizing safe events that protect the wellbeing of our student community. Therefore, we will do everything in our power to ensure a safe environment. However, participants attend any events at their own risk. We cannot guarantee that external people attending public event locations will not be infectious.
- Hand sanitizer must always be present at the entrance.
- We provide a QR code at the entrance of the event. All participants must scan it and leave their contact information behind, so that we can inform them if somebody reports to us they are tested positive.
- If you have been in contact with somebody who has COVID or you have any symptoms (even mild ones), you are not permitted to attend CIROS events.

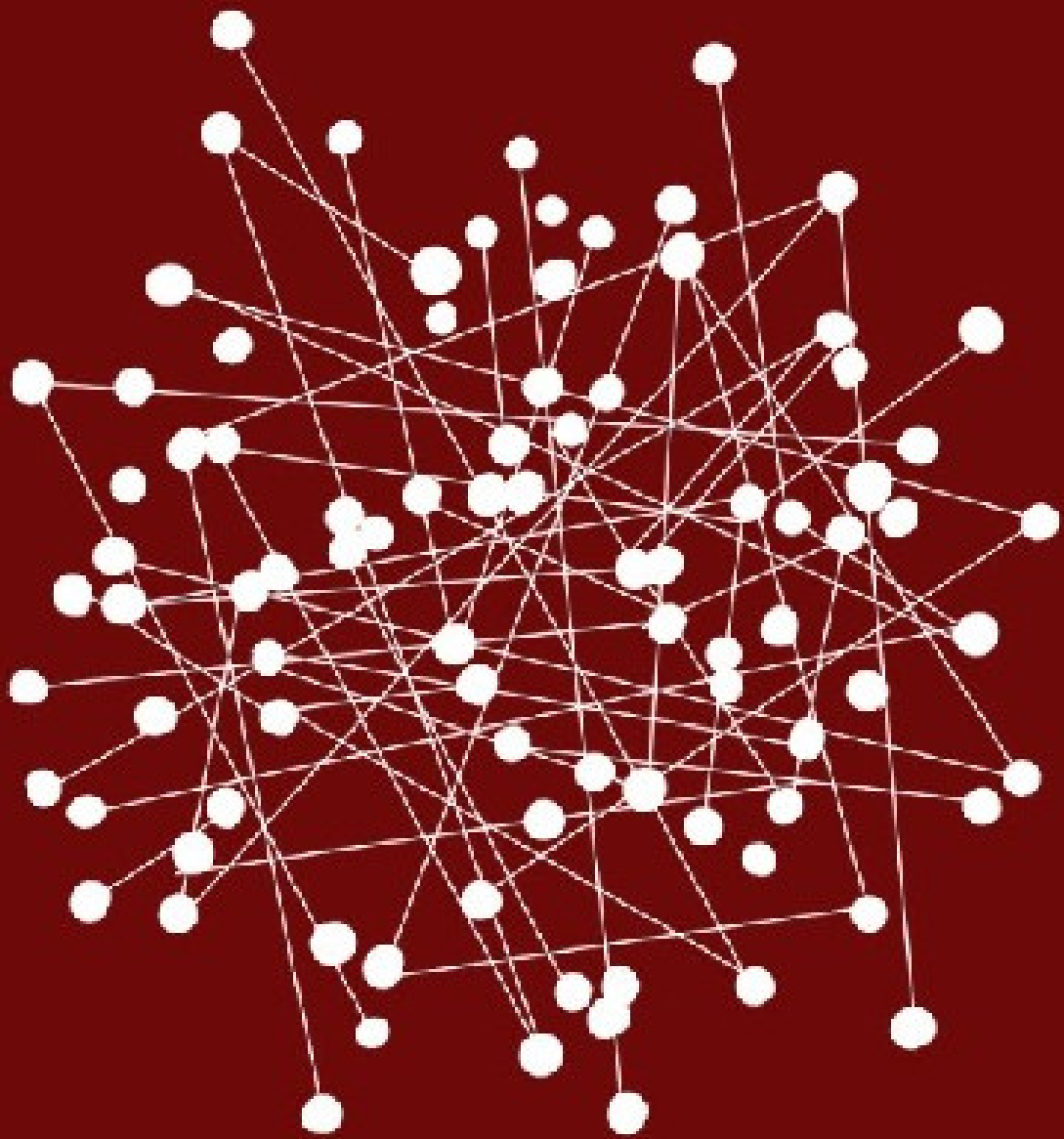
2. Outside Events

- The maximum number for outside events is 150 participants. This upper limit may not be exceeded.
- We ask you to keep your distance from your fellow students at all times. Protect each other and stay 1.5 meters apart. If the event location does not allow you to keep sufficient distance, we will ask you to wear masks while you are moving around.
- Sign up for the events that you want to attend in advance. This will help us prepare for the appropriate group size.
- If more than 50 participants attend the event you need to show your proof of vaccination or a negative quick test result to enter.
- If there are information stands and people are moving around, paths can only be used one way. This always needs to be marked clearly visible. This is the responsibility of the event organizers.

3. Inside Events

- The maximum number for inside events is 75 participants. This upper limit may not be exceeded.
- We ask you to keep your distance from your fellow students at all times. Protect each other and stay 1.5 meters apart.

- If you are moving around indoors, you need to wear a face mask that covers your mouth and nose. You can take this mask off once you are seated.
- Sign up for the events that you want to attend. This will help us prepare for the appropriate group size. If we offer time slots for you to attend, make sure you are at the event location at that time.
- For information markets with time slots the maximum group size that can be at the event location is 20 students. In that case, no quick tests or proofs of vaccination are required to enter.
- If the group size exceeds 20 participants you must show a proof of vaccination or negative quick test at the entrance.
- If there are information stands and people are moving around, paths can only be used one way. This always needs to be marked clearly visible. This is the responsibility of the event organizers.
