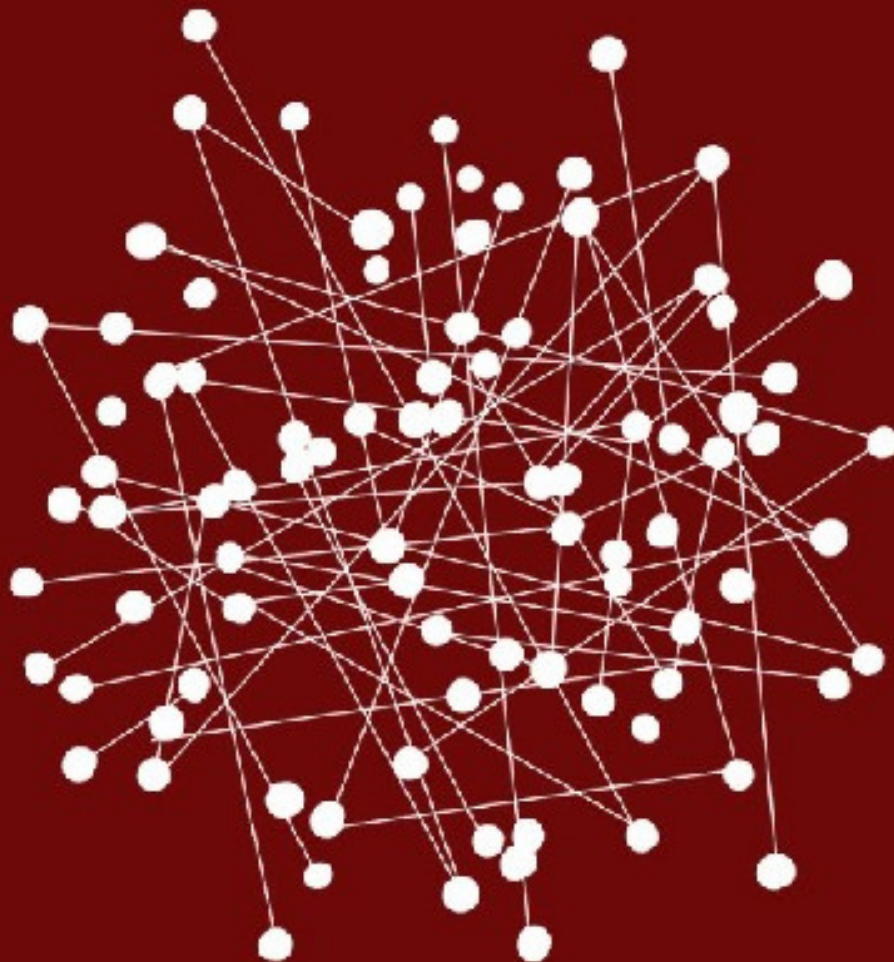

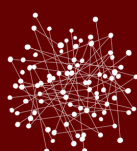

# 1. General

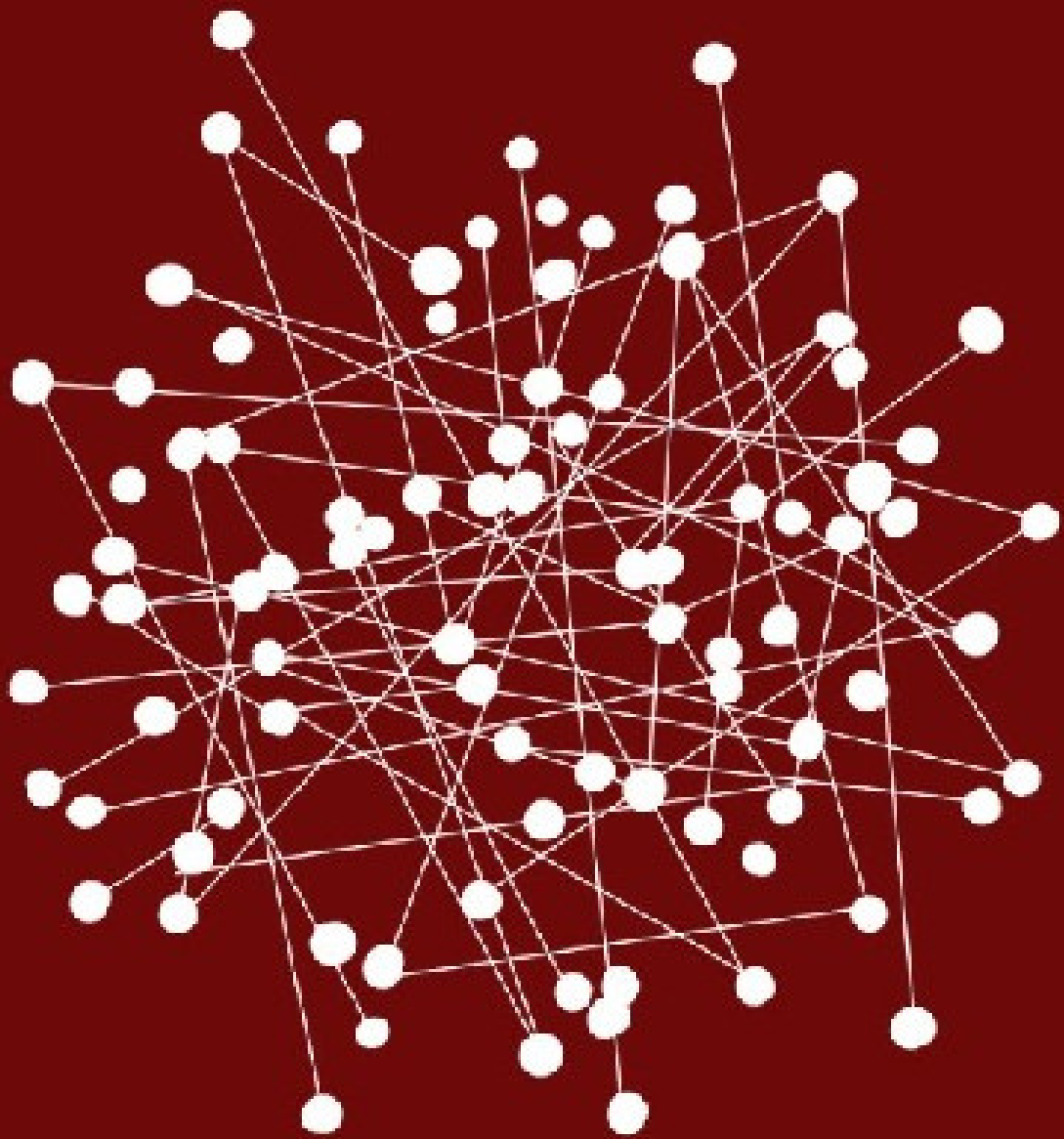
- These rules are subject to change and will be adjusted according to the current infection rates.
- CIROS is committed to organizing safe events that protect the wellbeing of our student community. Therefore, we will do everything in our power to ensure a safe environment. However, participants attend any events at their own risk. We cannot guarantee that external people attending public event locations will not be infectious.
- Hand sanitizer must always be present at the entrance.
- We collect personal information in sign-up forms to allow for contact tracing in case of a confirmed COVID case. By attending an event, you agree to the collection of this information.
- CIROS employs the “2G” system. This means that you are required to show a proof of vaccination or recovery to enter a CIROS event.
- If you have been in contact with somebody who has COVID, or if you have any COVID symptoms, you are not allowed to attend CIROS events until you have taken a PCR 5 days after being in contact and tested negative.

## 2. Inside Events

- At current infection rates, CIROS will not be organizing in-person events indoors.
- An exception is made for events which require pick-up or drop-off. In these cases, time-slots will be used, masks will be mandatory at all times, and social distancing will be enforced.
- Once events are deemed to be safe again, the previous guidelines apply once more:
  - The maximum number of participants for inside events is 75. This limit may not be exceeded.
  - You are required to always keep appropriate distance from your fellow students. Protect each other and stay 1.5 meters apart.
  - If you are moving around indoors, you need to wear a face mask that covers your mouth and nose. You can take this mask off once you are seated.
  - We ask you to sign up for the events that you want to attend in advance. This will help us prepare for the appropriate group size.
    - If we offer time slots for you to attend, make sure you are at the event location at that time.
  - CIROS employs the “2G” system. This means that you are required to show a proof of vaccination or recovery to enter a CIROS event.
  - If there are information stands and people are moving around, paths can only be used one way. This always needs to be marked clearly visible. This is the responsibility of the event organizers.

### 3. Outside Events

- At current infection rates, CIROS will not be organizing in-person events outdoors.
- Once events are deemed to be safe again, the previous guidelines apply once more:
  - The maximum number for outside events is 150 participants. This upper limit may not be exceeded.
  - We ask you to keep your distance from your fellow students at all times. Protect each other and stay 1.5 meters apart.
  - If the event location does not allow you to keep sufficient distance, we will ask you to wear masks while you are moving around.
  - We ask you to sign up for the events that you want to attend in advance. This will help us prepare for the appropriate group size.
  - If there are information stands and people are moving around, a one way system will be employed. This always needs to be marked clearly visible. This is the responsibility of the event organizers.
