

1. General


- These rules are subject to change and will be adjusted according to the current infection rates.
- CIROS is committed to organizing safe events that protect the wellbeing of our student community. Therefore, we will do everything in our power to ensure a safe environment. However, participants attend any events at their own risk. We cannot guarantee that external people attending public event locations will not be infectious.
- We collect personal information in sign-up forms to allow for contact tracing in case of a confirmed COVID case. By attending an event, you agree to the collection of this information.
- CIROS employs the **3G system**. This means that you are required to show a proof of vaccination, recovery, or a negative government provided test (no older than 24 hours) to enter a CIROS event.
- If you have been in contact with somebody who has COVID, or if you have any COVID symptoms, please follow government quarantine guidelines. A guide on what applies to you can be found here: <https://quarantainecheck.rijksoverheid.nl/en>
 - You are not allowed to attend CIROS events until you have tested negative through a government facilitated Antigen Test done at least 3 days after initial contact.
- Any event organized by CIROS will be assessed by the respective Committee Head(s) and Internal Affairs Officer(s) and suitable measures will be taken to ensure everyone's safety. Those include, but are not limited to, a reduction in numbers of attendees, re-introducing masks, as well as any other additional measures to ensure a safe environment during our events.

2. Inside Events

- The maximum number of participants for inside events is 200 people. This limit is subject to various considerations, including room/venue size and while it may not be exceeded, we reserve the right to reduce it depending on the type of event being held.
- We ask you to sign up for the events that you want to attend in advance.
- CIROS employs the 3G system. This means that you are required to show a proof of vaccination, recovery, or a negative government-provided test (no older than 24 hours) to enter a CIROS event.

3. Outside Events

- The maximum number of participants for outside events is 500 people.
- We ask you to sign up for the events that you want to attend in advance.
- CIROS employs the 3G system. This means that you are required to show a proof of vaccination, recovery, or a negative government-provided test (no older than 24 hours) to enter a CIROS event.
